BAGGOT ELECTED CHAIR OF AIRPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

FORT MYERS, Fla. (Feb. 2, 2010) – The Lee County Port Authority Airports Special Management Committee elected Dan Baggot as chair and Kevin Ostrowsky as vice chair during its Jan. 26, 2010 meeting. Other members of the Airports Special Management Committee include Joseph Burgess, Jeffrey Fridkin, Kitty Green, Rufus Lazzell and Fran Myers.

The committee advises the Lee County commissioners, sitting as the Board of Port Commissioners, on policy matters pertaining to Southwest Florida International Airport and Page Field General Aviation Airport in Fort Myers. Each Port Commissioner appoints one Airports Special Management Committee member, who serves without compensation. The committee also includes two regional members who represent the interests of neighboring Collier and Charlotte counties.

Southwest Florida International Airport served more than 7.4 million passengers in 2009 and is one of the top 50 U.S. airports for passenger traffic. Page Field General Aviation Airport provides services to corporate, commercial and private aviators and accommodated more than 75,000 aircraft operations in 2009.
